






GRAFFITI REMOVAL


Contract through Goodbye Graffiti, all graffiti is removed within the Newton BIA boundary ensuring that the area is graffiti-free.

USED NEEDLE DISPOSAL


With aim of reducing improperly discarded needles, needle collection boxes have been placed in highly reported areas, and managed by Raincity.


